This report provides summative information about COVID-19 positive results for our school community, since we began in person instruction on September 28th. **This is the total number of cases for the 2020-2021 school year**, up to this point in the year.

A positive case is a person who receives a lab-confirmed positive COVID-19 test result.

Student cases are counted from our total student population of 454, from both in person instruction and distance learning study rosters.

Staff includes all of our employees: administration, certificated and classified staff.
