- Risk assessment measures
 - 1. Campus closed...essential workers only
 - Symptom screening for COVID-19 for anyone entering and staying on campus *stop at the District Office for screening before proceeding anywhere on campus *temperature check
 - *questionnaire regarding personal health conditions and exposure possibilities *social distancing, masking, and hand sanitizing
 - Signage posted on campus...CDC signage
 *slow the spread, symptoms, stop the spread of germs, and how to protect yourself
- All staff will be trained in how to prevent the spread of the virus.
 - 1. Get Safety Trained COVID-19 training required by all employees
 - 2. CDC guidelines shared/signage posted throughout the campus
 - *Physical distancing...stay 6 feet apart from others
 - *Wear a cloth face covering to protect others
 - *Wash your hands often, use hand sanitizer when washing hands isn't available
 - *Do not touch your eyes, nose and mouth
 - *Clean frequently touched objects
 - *Cover your coughs and sneezes
 - *Stay at home if you are sick
 - 3. Weekly Zoom meetings held for all staff
 - *Tuesdays at 2...certificated
 - *Wednesdays at 9...classified
 - *Monthly scheduled meetings with employee representatives
 - 4. Compliance check
 - *Documentation of employee trainings
 - *Documentation of daily campus visitation/screening checklist
 - *Monitoring of appropriate protocols for physical distancing, masking and hand washing
 - 5. Response Team training
 - *Designated room for isolation purposes
 - *Assess symptoms...send home as needed...follow-up with healthcare provider
 - *Alert TC Public Health, TSCOS of suspected COVID-19
 - *Follow-up regarding COVID-19 illness and guarantine guidelines
